

White Wines

Ayrum Verdejo Blanco Albali, Valdepeñas (Spain)

This aromatic Verdejo shows oral notes with green apple and citrus fruit on the palate.

Vinuva Pinot Grigio delle Venezie (Italy)

Delicately favoured with notes of green apple and pear. Made by one of the regions leading organic producers.

Luis Felipe Edwards Lot 66 Sauvignon Blanc, Rapel Valley (Chile)

Hand harvested, gently pressed to retain the natural fruit aromas and flavour of citrus fruit, melon, pineapple and pear.

Luis Felipe Edwards Lot 35 Chardonnay, Rapel Valley (Chile)

Deliciously fresh, the wine has bright fruity aromas with lovely tropical flavours and balance.

Kleine Zalze Bush Vines Chenin Blanc, Stellenbosch (South African)

Soft and creamy, a hint of ripe exotic fruit and a delicious vanilla sweetness.

Viña Pomal Viura-Malvasía Rioja Blanco (Spain)

Rich with an aromatic citrus and white fruit character and a note of spice.

Waipara Hills Riesling, Waipara Valley (New Zealand)

Fresh and vibrant with a touch of sweetness, shows peach, alongside green apple, lime and floral oral notes.

Drylands Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough (New Zealand)

Sensational aromatic Sauvignon. Grapefruit and gooseberries lead into vibrant fresh cut grass, tropical fruit and crisp, refreshing finish

We Recommend

Gavi di Gavi La Toledana, Domini Villa Lanata (Italy)

Un-oaked it shows exotic fruits, floral notes and hints of honey

Chablis, Louis Jadot (France)

A fuller style of Chablis, still typically bone-dry, but also with a well-rounded finish and subtle hints of toasty-vanilla oak flavours.

Sancerre, La Graveliere, Joseph Mellot (France)

Vibrant, aromatic Sauvignon Blanc at its best, opulent on the nose and palate, stylishly dry on the finish

Sparkling Wine & Champagne

Da Luca Prosecco (Italy)

Pear and peach fruit on a lively, yet soft and generous palate.

Anna de Codorníu Brut Rosé, Cava (Spain)

Very fine elegant Cava with lots of style and finesse, strawberry and raspberry fruit with a hint of fresh bread.

Veuve Clicquot Yellow Label Brut (France)

Reflecting the traditions of the past, this is full, yet dry and has a rich, creamy style with biscuity flavours.

Bollinger Special Cuvée Brut (France)

With a reputation for being big and full-flavoured, the richness and yeasty tones give a long stylish finish.

Veuve Clicquot Brut Rosé (France)

Luminous, fresh, pink with initial aromas of red fruits leading to dried fruits and biscuit notes.

Laurent-Perrier Cuvée Rosé Brut (France)

The briefest liaison with grape skins tantalisingly leaves this delicate colour yet exudes a floral fragrance evolving soft red berry richness.

Dom Pérignon Brut (France)

Long and satisfying on the palate with layers of yeasty, nutty flavours, superbly fat and ripe. Complex, luxury Grand Cru Champagne made only in the best years.

Red Wines

Ayrum Tempranillo Tinto Albali, Valdepeñas (Spain)

Cherry-red, very smooth with blackberry and plum fruit: the tannins are light and finish soft.

Luis Felipe Edwards Lot 18 Merlot, Rapel Vally (Chile)

Soft, smooth, approachable Merlot with rounded cherries and spiced plums.

Berri Estates Shiraz (Australia)

Medium-bodied and fruity with raspberry, cherry and plum, complemented by vanilla spices.

Portillo Malbec, Uco Valley, Mendoza (Argentina)

Plums, blackberries and a touch of vanilla: fresh fruit flavours, supported by a touch of spice.

Viña Pomal Centenario Rioja Crianza (Spain)

Black fruit, liquorice and subtle mineral notes, cocoa and toasty notes from barrel ageing: supple and balanced.

Montepulciano d’Abruzzo Vigne Nuove, Valle Reale (Italy)

Exuding spectacular blueberry and plum flavours, very rich, mouth-filling, warm and upfront with liquorice hints.

Passori Rosso Veneto (Italy)

THE BABY AMARONE! Rich, smooth red wine, showing plum and dried fruit followed by notes of spice and vanilla.

We Recommend

Bethany g6 Shiraz, Barossa Valley (Australia)

The aroma is generous and the mouth-feel elegant yet full flavoured, whilst the lingering finish is delightful blend of blackberry fruit and restrained oak spice.

Veramonte Pinot Noir Reserva, Casablanca Valley (Chile)

Pinot Noir flourishes in the cool climate of Casablanca Valley: delicious cherry and strawberry fruit flavours.

Salentein Barrel Selection Malbec, Uco Valley, Mendoza (Argentina)

Notes of ripe blackberry, blueberry and redcurrant, with subtle hints of violet. The silky palate offers a crisp, balance backed by vanilla on the lingering finish.

Viña Real Rioja Reserva (Spain)

Gorgeously fragrant with soft fruit, warm spices and elegant toasty oak aromas.

The Federalist Visionary Zinfandel Dry Creek Valley (USA)

Fruit forward with blackberry and black cherry aromas and spicy notes: the palate is balanced and mouth-filling with a rich texture and long finish.

The Federalist Dueling Pistols Zinfandel-Syrah, Dry Creek Valley (USA)

Weighty with rich, ripe fruit and a lively acidity that carries the fruit through to a long finish.

Rosé

Ayrum Tempranillo Rosado Albali, Valdepeñas (Spain)

Salmon-pink with red highlights, a soft and fruity rosé showing notes of strawberry jam and citrus on the finish.

Vendange White Zinfandel, California (USA)

A brief time with juice and skin together gives this delicate colour, delicious strawberry aroma and zingy freshness.

We Recommend

Belvino Pinot Grigio Rosato delle Venezie (Italy)

Slightly drier in style, full of fresh summer berry fruit aromas.
